



**National Advisory Committee on Blood and Blood Products
Confidentiality Agreement: Meeting Observers and Ad Hoc Attendees**

Observation of meetings involving national transfusion medicine experts and Provincial/ Territorial Ministry of Health representatives serves as an important educational opportunity and is a privilege. Permission for trainee observers or ad hoc members to attend National Advisory Committee on Blood and Blood Products (NAC) or National Emergency Blood Management Committee (NEBMC) meetings may be granted upon request or expressed invitation.

Discussions which occur at meetings of the NAC and/or NEBMC may include topics of a sensitive or confidential nature. Observers must be aware that information discussed at NAC and/or NEBMC meetings should be considered confidential, unless related conversations are about information already publicly available, or documents disseminated broadly. Further conversations about topics not already publicly available should only occur with other NAC members, unless there is an expressed request at the meeting to proceed with conversations about specific topics with relevant community stakeholders.

Observers at NAC and/or NEBMC Meetings shall confirm that they will agree to uphold the principles of this Confidentiality Agreement.
